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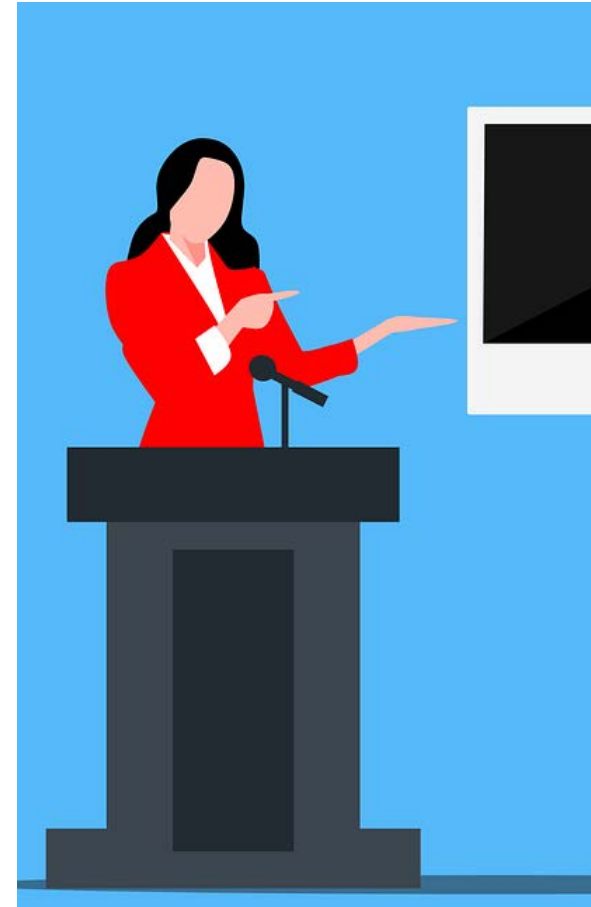

Giving conference presentations

- Tell a story & tailor it to audience
 - structure talk according what they expect (formula)
 - what can you presume your audience already knows?
- Make slides accessible; increase readability
 - Cut excess verbiage
 - Use strong colour contrasts
 - 24-point font minimum (20-point for unessential info)
- Unambiguous pictures (CC license) & diagrams easier to absorb
- Dry-runs/self-rehearsals can help with delivery, polish, flow
- Presenting can be nerve-racking, but it's your chance to shine
